



## ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT *Sixth through Eighth Grade*

A language arts course is offered from 9 A.M. to 11 A.M., and a math course is offered from 11:00 A.M. to noon. Students have the option of attending one or two three-week sessions and may take one or both of the offerings during each three-week session.

### SESSION I June 23 - July 11\*

**Debate:** Combines writing, organizing, and developing concise thoughts, as well as oral presentations. Students examine both sides of an issue, develop logical arguments for their position, and use persuasive techniques to defend their position. 9 A.M. – 11 A.M.

**Math Investigations:** See the power of mathematics as it cuts through deception and flawed thinking in real-life situations. Discover how a mathematical miscalculation caused a commercial airline to run out of fuel at 41,000 feet, and whether the use of corn-based ethanol will really lower our dependence on oil--and much more. 11 A.M. - Noon

### SESSION II July 14 - August 1

**Literary Workshop:** Join a tour of great authors from around the world. Compare the writing styles of various authors such as Ray Bradbury, Jack London, and Rudyard Kipling, analyzing their use of similes, metaphors, foreshadowing, dramatic irony, point of view, symbolism, hyperbole, persona, and figurative language. 9 A.M.- 11 A.M.

**Mathcounts:** Designed to promote logical thinking and sharpen analytical abilities. Solve challenging, multi-step problems using a variety of methods; exercise the mathematical part of the brain; and have a good time while learning. 11 A.M. – Noon
